POWER STATION LLC AWARDED JACKSONVILLE CONTRACT

Power Station LLC is pleased to announce that it succeeded in its bid for the Specialty Concession Contract at Jacksonville International Airport (“JAA”). The contract includes the introduction of the Company’s PowerPort brand Automated Business Center, together with two traditional PowerPort units to be placed post-security in the airport’s passenger terminal areas. Jacksonville International serves approximately 2.5 million enplaned passengers annually, with total passengers exceeding 5 million. The Automated Business Center will be constructed in the terminal building’s central passenger hub (pre-security), providing access to all passenger traffic.

Matt Buscher, President of Power Station, said: “We’re excited to have prevailed at JAA, and look forward to expanding the PowerPort brand into Florida, adding JAA to the Company’s ever-growing list of airport installations, and our Business Center brand now stretches from San Francisco International to Florida. Jacksonville provides ideal current and increasing traffic volume, and we’re proud to be a part of the City’s preparations for the Super Bowl this year”.

The JAA Business Center is planned to be operative by the end of January 2005, with the installation of the first PowerPort to follow in March, with a second in May of 2005.

Power Station LLC is a consumer product design and service company which has developed the PowerPort for installation at airports, convention centers and other strategic sites. The PowerPort delivers a full suite of services including a convenient means of charging laptop computers, wireless WebPads for use in accessing the Internet, Wi-Fi Internet access for wireless users, ChargePads for use as portable batteries for laptops, walk-up power and Internet access, and automated business center management.

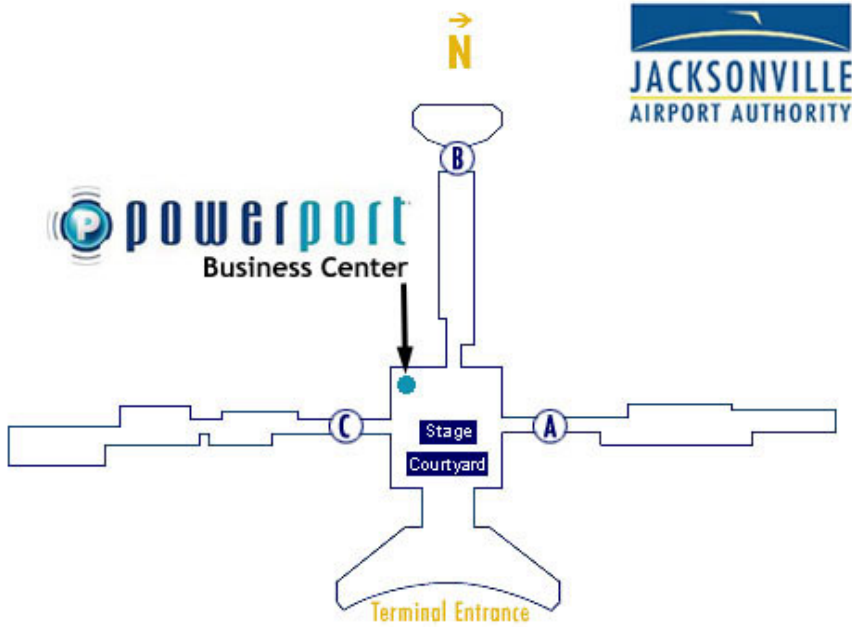
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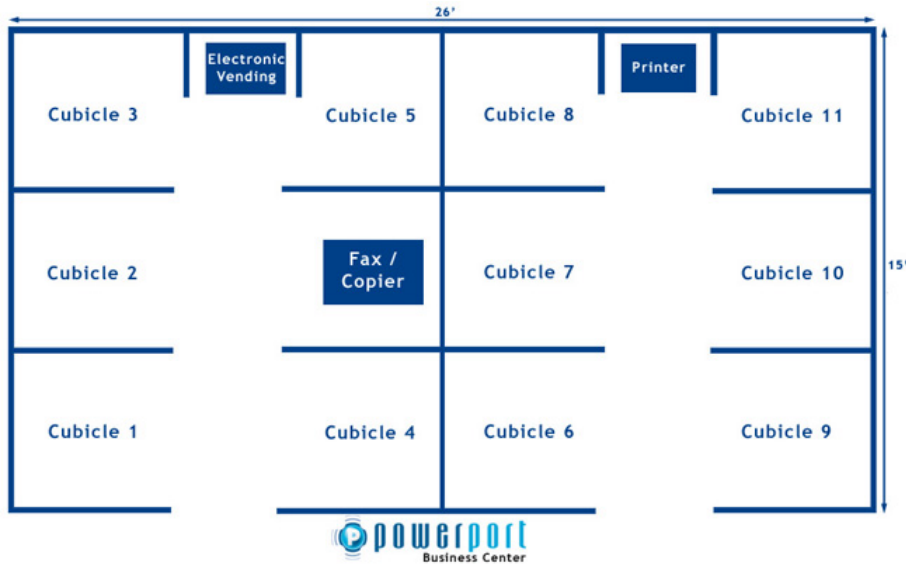
